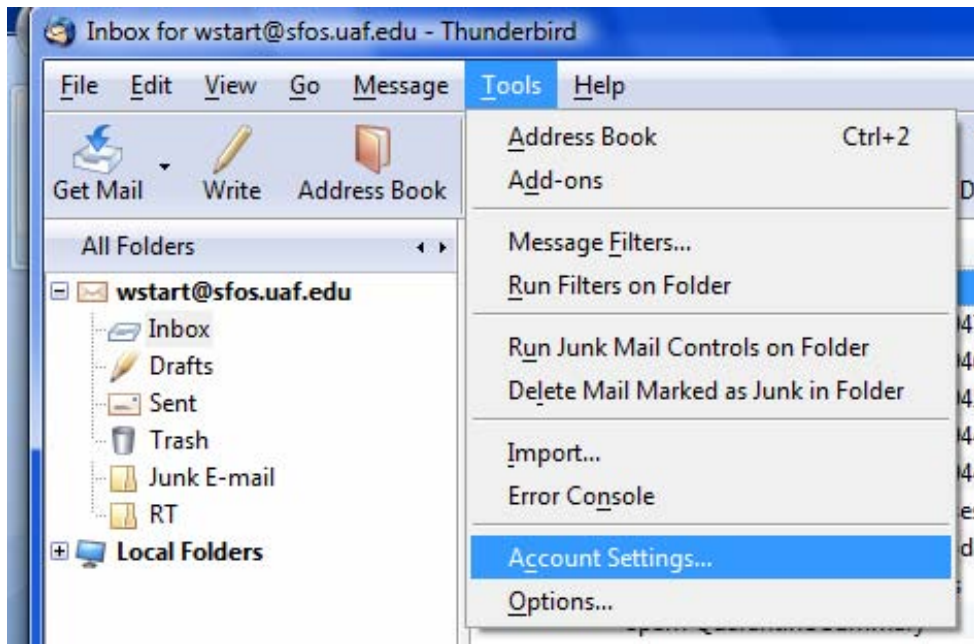
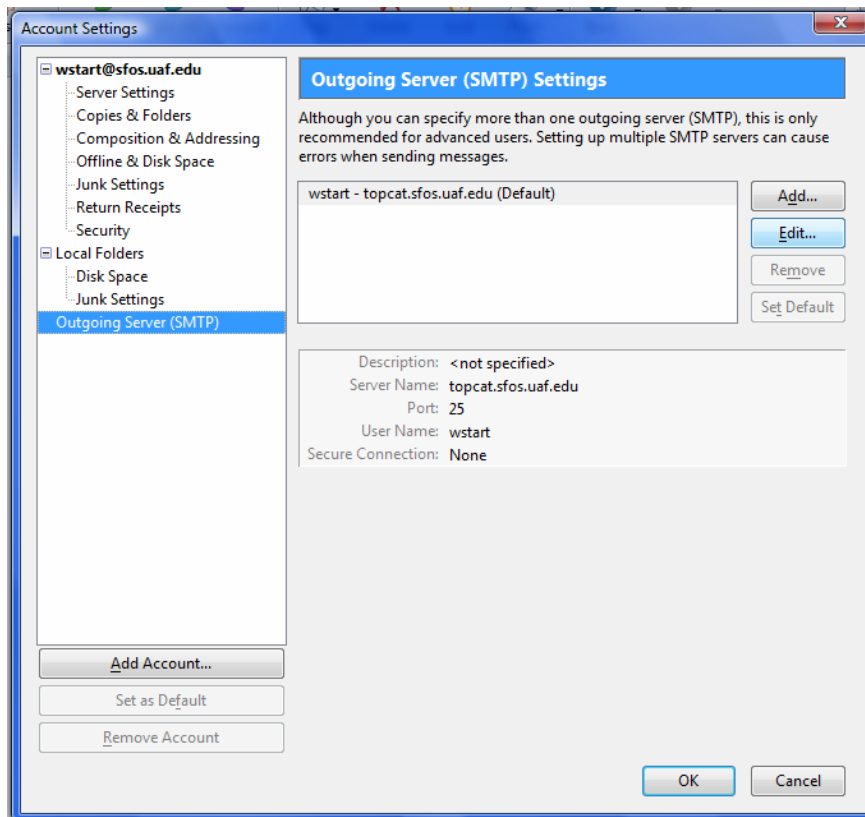


## Thunderbird – changing outgoing mail server


1. Goto Tools -> Account Settings.



2. On the left side, click on “**Outgoing Server (SMTP)**” and on the right side, select your **SFOS email** account and click **Edit**.



3. Change the **Server Name** field to **hubbard.sfos.uaf.edu**
